

But most of all, HAVE FUN!






## **THEME:**

The world is drawing to a near end. Nature has finally taken its toll and disaster has caused all continents to wash away. The scientists had developed labs for exactly the same purpose. Ones that would exist beyond disaster. The labs are only three in number. You look around. You seem to be a lone survivor. You reach the lab in Mumbai, while the other two are in Tokyo and New York.

The computers of the lab can only interact in encrypted messages. To communicate with people, if there are any, in Tokyo or New York, you must decrypt these messages. You must communicate, you must decipher, to know what to do next, and most importantly, to survive.

## **OBJECTIVE:**

The objective of the participant is to solve the encrypted messages. The solutions may earn you marks, or may lead you to further clues and messages depending on the round you are in.





## **TEAM SPECIFICATIONS:**

Only individual participants are allowed to appear for the test.

## **CERTIFICATE POLICY:**

1. Certificate of participation will be awarded to all the participants and certificate of excellence will be given to the top three participants.

## **COMPETITION OUTLINE:**

### **Round 1**

Participants will have to complete a Quiz on Google Forms. There will be 3 sections with 25 questions each. The questions will have different weightage, but the total score per section will be the same. There is no negative marking. None of the questions will be compulsory, which means you may choose to skip it, but all of them will be graded. So, the more questions you solve correctly, the higher will be your score. There will be ten sets of questions (created using a branched form and a separate question bank form) with similar levels of difficulty. The questions will either be MCQs or multiple answers




## Round 2

1. Selected participants are given 5 .pdf files. (These files will be sent to participants via Google classroom).
2. The file 1 has 10 questions. Question 1 to 9 will be of the same difficulty level. Question 10 will be the hardest. The answers to these questions unlock the other password-protected files. Files 2 to 4 will have 2 questions each - 1 moderate and 1 hard. File 5 will have 1 very difficult question. But it will have the highest weightage.
3. File 2: Unlocked from the code formed by answers to questions 1, 4 and 7.
4. File 3: Unlocked from the code formed by answers to questions 2, 5 and 8.
5. File 4: Unlocked from the code formed by answers to questions 3, 6 and 9.
6. File 5: Unlocked from the code formed by answers to questions 3, 5, 7 and 10.
7. Each question in each pdf will be assigned a question ID. None of the questions will be MCQs. The answers have to be entered in a google form which only has the question IDs and no question text. All the answers will be of short answer form and they must be typed in.



## SCORING SYSTEM:

Round	Total Points	Point Distribution
1	150	50 points per section x 3 sections
2	100	<i>File 1:</i> 4 points per question for questions 1 to 9, 12 points for question 10; <i>File 2 - 4:</i> 4 points for moderate difficulty level question, 8 points for hard difficulty level question; <i>File 5:</i> 16 points for 1 question





## **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Registered candidates will receive a confirmation email specifying date of their exam.
2. Form will be sent 15 minutes prior for entering details and reading instructions. At the time it starts, the organizers will provide a password which has to be entered to access the questions. 5 minutes extra will be given for submission. No request for deadline extension will be entertained. The organizers may change the timings as they see fit.
3. Any participant found to be resorting to unfair means during the conduction of the test will be disqualified.
4. Layout of rounds or Format can be changed by the organizers of events at any point of time.
5. No rash behavior with the organizers will be tolerated.
6. While attending quizzes or submitting pdfs and other materials for your work or attending interactive rounds, make sure you are well connected to the internet as no complaints regarding low internet speed or poor connections will be entertained and the time period given for the particular round will be followed strictly.
7. Organizers decision will be the final decision.
